WHAT MUST BE DONE TO SECURE FUTURE IMPROVEMENT?

The quality and standards of the care

To improve the quality and standards of care further the registered person should take account of the following recommendation(s):

- ensure that all role play areas are kept sufficiently resourced, to effectively support and encourage children's learning and development
- ensure that suitable arrangements are in place to safeguard the welfare of the children, should the kindergarten premises need to be evacuated, and be deemed unsafe to re-occupy, and that parents are informed of these arrangements
- implement fully the risk assessment procedures, so as to ensure the continued suitability of the premises, resources and equipment
- ensure that Ofsted is informed of any significant changes or events, including those in respect of the staff complement.

The quality and standards of the nursery education

To improve the quality and standards of nursery education further the registered person should take account of the following recommendation(s):

- consider providing older children with the opportunity to make choices and serve their own food at meal times, so as to further promote self help and decision making skills
- ensure sufficient resources and activities are provided during outdoor play, so as to develop and enhance children's gross motor skills, and provide sufficient challenge for all children (also applies to care)
- consider how more frequent visits to places of interest may be incorporated into the programme of planned activities to raise children's awareness of the wider world (also applies to care).
