Ofsted 2011–12 good practice survey inspection programme: improving science in colleges

Features of good practice

- Comprehensive curriculum planning has led to the development of a broad range of science provision.
- The progression of vocational learners is good.
- The well-organised and effective staff training helps them to update their subject knowledge and further develop their teaching skills.
- Learners write and produce a high-quality monthly science magazine.

Areas for improvement, which we discussed, include:

 making more effective use of the science laboratories at the Southend and Basildon campuses. I hope that these observations are useful as you continue to develop science provision.
