Interim assessment of St Mary's College Blackburn

Colleges and providers are generally inspected within four years of their last inspection. This interval may be extended up to six years if the overall effectiveness grade is good.

In addition to an annual risk assessment for each provider, which informs the annual inspection programme, Ofsted has undertaken to conduct interim desk based assessments on good providers three years after their last full inspection.
