Outcome of monitoring visit for provision judged as inadequate

An Ofsted inspector, Dawn Woodhouse-wykes, carried out a monitoring visit of your provision on 25/03/2013. This visit follows on from your inspection where the provision was judged to be inadequate.

Outcome of the visit

As a result of our inspection on 04/02/2013, we sent you a notice to improve.

The notice to improve required you to ensure that procedures for safeguarding children are robust and safe, with particular regard to carrying younger children in the car when collecting children from school.

Having considered all the evidence, the inspector is of the opinion that at this time you are making satisfactory improvement overall.

Overall effectiveness of the improvement and outcomes for children

Since the inspection visit the childminder has made satisfactory progress in meeting the notice to improve. The childminder ensures all children are taken to collect other children from school and no child is left unsupervised in the car. The childminder has reviewed her collection and drop off policy and has amended her risk assessments for school/nursery runs.

Next steps

Having considered all the evidence the inspector is of the opinion that at this time:

- The childminder has made satisfactory improvement. The next visit will be a full inspection.
