Outcome of monitoring visit for provision judged as inadequate

An Ofsted inspector, Joan Isabel Madden, carried out a monitoring visit of your provision on 23/07/2013. This visit follows on from your inspection where the provision was judged to be inadequate.

Outcome of the visit

As a result of our inspection on 26/06/2013, we sent you a welfare requirements notice.

In addition to the welfare requirement notice you were also issued a notice to improve.

The welfare notice required you to complete the following actions by 22 July 2013: obtain an enhanced Disclosure and Barring Service check in respect of every person aged 16 and over who works directly with children as part of an effective system to ensure their suitability to work with children (Suitable People W2.1 3.9).

The notice to improve set out two actions that asked you to: record information about staff qualifications

to enable effective monitoring of staff deployment (Suitable people 3.12 W2.1) and ensure effective systems are in place to ensure that any person caring for, or in regular contact with children is suitable to work with children which include obtaining an enhanced Disclosure and Barring Service check Childcare Register CR3)

Having considered all the evidence, the inspector is of the opinion that at this time the setting is making good improvement overall.

Overall effectiveness of the improvement and outcomes for children

Since the inspection the provider has made good progress. Procedures ensure that





the staff are suitably vetted, experienced and qualified to work with children and the required adult to child ratios are met at all times. In gathering evidence it was found that the provider records information about staff qualifications to enable effective monitoring of staff deployment.

Next steps

Having considered all the evidence the inspector is of the opinion that at this time:

• The setting has made good improvement. The next visit will be a full inspection.
