Monitoring for provision judged as inadequate

An Ofsted inspector, Lindsay Dobson, monitored your provision on 12/06/2014 following your inspection where the provision was judged to be inadequate.

Outcome of monitoring

As a result of our inspection on 04/04/2014, we sent you a notice to improve. If you were set actions at the inspection, or as a result of our subsequent monitoring or investigations, these are included at the end of this letter unless we have already verified that they have been completed.

During the monitoring visit the inspector discussed with you the steps you have taken to address the action raised in the notice to improve. She reviewed how you safeguard children and your knowledge and understanding of the safeguarding and welfare requirements of the Early Years Foundation Stage. The inspector asked questions about your knowledge and understanding of signs and symptoms of child abuse and how you would recognise, record and report any concerns that may arise. The inspector discussed and looked at your safeguarding policies and procedures and the other documents you have, to support you to ensure children are protected and kept safe. The inspector spoke to a representative from the local authority and observed your engagement with the children in your care.

The inspector found that you have worked through a thorough action plan detailing the steps you have taken to address the issue raised at your last inspection. You have completed a safeguarding refresher training course and updated your policies and procedures. This has improved your knowledge of the signs and symptoms of child abuse and neglect and provided clear information as to the steps you would take to safeguard children.

Having considered all the evidence, the inspector is of the opinion that the childminder has taken prompt and effective action to address the points for improvement.
