

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

On 29 November 2013 the provider notified Ofsted of an allegation against a member of staff. The notification means that the provider met their legal requirements as set out in the Early Years Foundation Stage welfare requirements to notify Ofsted of significant events. Ofsted carried out an investigation and found that there had been a lack of understanding in relation to following the safeguarding procedures and that some staff did not always manage challenging behaviour effectively. However, the investigation also found that swift and effective action had been taken by the owner and managers to resolve the issues highlighted by the allegation. A full inspection of the provision was carried out on 18 February 2014 after the investigation was closed. The provider remains registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action
