Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- The childminder demonstrates a sufficient knowledge of how to effectively implement the learning and development requirements of the Early Years Foundation Stage.
- The childminder has developed good relationships with other settings that children attend. This ensures consistency in supporting children's individual care and learning needs.
- The childminder understands the importance of developing a caring relationship with children to support their development, and to help them feel safe and secure in their environment.
- The childminder values ongoing professional development. She regularly upgrades her skills and understanding, which benefits the children she cares for and helps to improve the service she provides.
- The childminder has addressed the actions raised from her last inspection. Consequently, she ensures all relevant documentation is readily available and well maintained, including a policy for managing children's behaviour and all consent forms from parents.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

Inspection activities

- The inspector viewed all areas used for childminding purposes, including facilities in the play room and outdoors.
- The inspector viewed relevant documentation, including the childminder's policies and procedures as well as suitability checks for adults living in the household.
- The inspector held discussions with the childminder about the actions raised at the last inspection and her process for self-evaluation.

The childminder registered in 1992. She lives with her adult son in a two-storey town house, situated in the area of Canada Waters, Southwark. The living room on the first floor is the main area used for childminding, with access to the ground floor bathroom facilities. A garden is available for outdoor play. The childminder is registered on the Early Years Register and the compulsory and voluntary parts of the Childcare Register. There were no children present at the time of the inspection.

This inspection was carried out by Ofsted under sections 49 and 50 of the Childcare Act 2006 on the quality and standards of provision that is registered on the Early Years Register.
