Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- The childminder has a secure knowledge and understanding of safeguarding issues, she is aware how to protect children from harm to promote children's welfare.
- The childminder has a good knowledge of children's learning and development. She makes sure children learn through their play by providing a variety of resources that children can freely access.
- The childminder provides a safe and welcoming environment. She prepares freshly cooked meals which promote children's good health.
- The childminder has systems in place to help children settle very well, including children learning English as an additional language.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

- The inspector spoke to the childminder during the inspection and discussed how she delivers the educational programmes for children.
- The inspector looked at a sample of documentation, including policies and procedures.
- The inspector viewed the premises and equipment used by children.
