## Summary of key findings for parents

### The provision does not meet requirements

- Staff do not keep children safe in regard to e-safety. As a result, children can access uncensored websites. This puts them at risk and is also a breach of the requirements of the Childcare Register.
- Staff do not ensure children's safety regarding mobile phones. The setting's mobile phone has a camera and video recording facilities and is frequently left within reach of children and other people. This puts children at risk and is also a breach of the Childcare Register.
- Staff do not have a sufficient understanding of their role and responsibility to deliver the requirements of the Early Years Foundation Stage. This affects several aspects of children's care.
- Staff demonstrate team work and communicate effectively with each other.
- The setting has adequate security in place to ensure no one enters the premises without the staff accompanying them.
- Staff provide resources that show positive images of children's cultural backgrounds. This helps children to feel valued and to learn about differences.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

## What the setting needs to do to improve further

### To meet the requirements of the Early Years Foundation Stage the provider must:

- ensure children are safeguarded while using the computer so they cannot access uncensored websites
- ensure the setting's mobile phone is kept out of reach in order to safeguard children
- improve staff's understanding of the Early Years Foundation Stage and their responsibility to meet all requirements.

### To meet the requirements of the Childcare Register the provider must:

- ensure that staff implement effective procedures to safeguard children
- ensure that staff implement effective procedures to safeguard children.

### Inspection activities

- The inspector observed activities and staff's interaction with the older children.
- The inspector held a meeting with the manager/nominated person.
- The inspector checked evidence of the suitability and qualifications of staff working with the children and the provider's procedures for self-evaluation.

Hounslow Heath After-School Care registered in 1993. It is managed by a voluntary management committee, comprised of parents whose children attend the setting. The club operates from a purpose-built class room within Hounslow Heath Infant School, in the London Borough of Hounslow. The club is registered on the Early Years Register and the compulsory and voluntary parts of the Childcare Register. It operates each weekday during term time from 3.30pm to 5.45pm providing after-school care for children attending Hounslow Heath Infant and Junior schools only. The club employs two staff. The manager holds an appropriate early years qualification at level 3 and the other member of staff has a relevant qualification at level 2. There were no children in the early years age range present on the day of inspection.

This inspection was carried out by Ofsted under sections 49 and 50 of the Childcare Act 2006 on the quality and standards of provision that is registered on the Early Years Register. The registered person must ensure that this provision complies with the statutory framework for children's learning, development and care, known as the Early Years Foundation Stage.

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
