## Summary of key findings for parents

### The provision meets requirements

- The childminder has developed her understanding of the learning and development requirements and is very aware of ensuring she meets each child's individual interests and needs through fun and exciting activities.
- The childminder has a strong understanding of ensuring children's safety in the home and when on outings. She understands how to protect children health and well-being.
- The childminder has a clear understanding of working in partnership with parents and in sharing the children's developmental records on a regular basis.
- The childminder has a good awareness of safeguarding children. She keeps herself up to date by attending training courses and conferences. This demonstrates her capacity to improve.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.
