## Summary of key findings for parents

### The provision meets requirements

- The childminder is able to demonstrate a thorough understanding of the learning and development requirements, in order to encourage children's progress. She is aware of the need to work in partnership with parents to support children's continuing development.
- The childminder maintains a safe and welcoming home with suitable resources to provide good quality learning experiences for all children. The childminder understands the importance of ensuring children have daily opportunities to experience learning and physical play in the fresh air.
- The childminder has a suitable knowledge of child protection procedures. She has completed relevant training to ensure she is aware of the current procedures. The childminder fully understands her responsibility to protect the welfare of the child.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

### Inspection activities

- The inspector had discussions with the childminder about how she would support and promote children's learning and development needs.
- The inspector checked the childminder's understanding of child protection and discussed how she keeps children safe.
- The inspector looked around the areas of the home available to minded children.
