Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- The childminder has a clear understanding of how to assess children's abilities and plan to meet their learning and developmental needs to aid their progress across the areas of learning. She knows what appropriate play activities and experiences to offer children according to their individual needs.
- The childminder understands how to manage children's different behaviours, how to teach them to behave in safe ways, how to keep them safe, and how to maintain their good health in order to meet their care needs and promote their well-being.
- The childminder has a clear understanding of all the requirements of her registration. She maintains necessary documentation and understands the need to keep improving her provision. She has recently attended child protection training and is clear on the correct procedures to take if worried about a child's welfare.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

Inspection activities

- The inspector viewed the premises and play resources with the childminder.
- The inspector looked at documents provided by the childminder.
- The inspector discussed the provider's self-evaluation and points for improvement
- The inspector discussed how the childminder plans to meet children's learning and care needs, including through assessing children's abilities and planning for their progress, risk assessing the home and promoting children's good health.
