## Summary of key findings for parents

### The provision meets requirements

- The provider and all staff demonstrate a clear knowledge of how to keep children safe. All staff have first aid and safeguarding training to support children's welfare and well-being.
- The provider recognises the importance of working in partnership with parents to support their children's care. They exchange information about their learning experiences and school day which enhances consistency.
- The provider provides an environment that helps children to feel safe and show high levels of independence, while playing with activities that meet their interests.
- The provider understands the need for the supervision and professional development of staff. This includes opportunities to expand their knowledge and understanding through training to improve the provision for children.
- The provider shows a good awareness of how to promote the children's safety. For example, she completes a daily risk assessment and has measures to reduce any potential hazards.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

## **Inspection activities**

- The inspector viewed all the areas of the provision available for children's use, including toys, resources and equipment.
- The inspector discussed with the provider her understanding, knowledge and procedures in place for safeguarding.

Whitstable Junior School Breakfast and Afterschool Club registered in 2012 and operates from two rooms in the junior school building. The school is situated in the town centre of Whitstable, Kent. Breakfast club operates from 7.30am to 9am and the after school club operates from 3.15pm to 6pm, term time only. The holiday club operates from 8am to 6pm during school holidays. The breakfast and afterschool club is registered on the Early Years Register and the compulsory and voluntary parts of the Childcare Register. There are four members of staff, two of whom hold an appropriate play work qualification to National Vocational Level 3, with one member of staff holding an NVQ 2.

This inspection was carried out by Ofsted under sections 49 and 50 of the Childcare Act 2006 on the quality and standards of provision that is registered on the Early Years Register. The registered person must ensure that this provision complies with the statutory framework for children's learning, development and care, known as the Early Years Foundation Stage.

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
