

## **Compliance action taken for childcare provision**

### **Summary of outcome**

On 15 January 2015 we received a notification from the provider that raised concerns about the procedures for accident and injury at the setting.

We carried out an unannounced visit and looked into these concerns to see whether the setting was meeting the Early Years Foundation Stage requirements for accident and injury and child supervision.

We found that staff: child ratios are maintained at the setting, that children are appropriately supervised and that steps are taken to ensure a safe environment. We also found however, that risk assessment procedures are not sufficiently rigorous and do not include all relevant information. This could prevent the provider identifying and managing potential hazards to children and staff.

We sent the provider a notice to improve that asked them to:

-ensure that risk assessments identify aspects of the environment that need to be checked on a regular basis, when and by whom those aspects will be checked, and how the risk will be removed or minimised.

We are happy with the response they provided and this will also be checked at the next inspection.

### **Publication of compliance action**

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those

registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years commencing on the date we complete our investigation.
