The setting does not meet legal requirements for early years settings

Summary of key findings for parents

The provision does not meet requirements

- Evidence of the designated lead practitioner completing safeguarding training, in line with statutory requirements, is not available to demonstrate that knowledge of how to keep children safe is current.
- Evidence of staff completing paediatric first-aid training, in line with statutory requirements, is not available to demonstrate an up-to-date knowledge of how staff can respond to emergencies.
- Staff understand how to support children's well-being and how the provision of a calm, secure and welcoming environment helps children to develop secure relationships with staff.
- Staff demonstrate an understanding of how the provision of a range of resources and learning opportunities will support meeting the learning and development needs of all children, including those with special educational needs and/or disabilities.
- Staff understand how to support children's physical and emotional well-being. They understand how to support children to be happy and confident in making choices in their play, through provision of an environment that is welcoming, safe and stimulating.
- Staff understand how effective partnerships, between parents and school staff, support children to progress with their learning and development.
- Staff understand how to implement effective behaviour management strategies to enable children to deal with conflict well. They demonstrate an understanding of how they can support children to be emotionally secure and healthy.
- Staff know how to implement the requirements of the Early Years Foundation Stage and how to prepare children for school or the next stage in their learning.
- Staff understand their full responsibilities in meeting the safeguarding and welfare requirements of the Early Years Foundation Stage and how to keep children safe in line with their safeguarding policy.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

What the setting needs to do to improve further

To meet the requirements of the Early Years Foundation Stage the provider must:

- ensure the designated lead practitioner completes a relevant child protection training course
- ensure at least one person on the premises caring for children has a current paediatric first-aid certificate.

To meet the requirements of the Childcare Register the provider must:

- ensure at least one person caring for children completes relevant paediatric first-aid training (compulsory part of the Childcare Register)
- ensure the designated lead practitioner for safeguarding completes relevant child protection training (compulsory part of the Childcare Register)
- ensure at least one person caring for children completes relevant paediatric first-aid training (voluntary part of the Childcare Register).

Inspection activities

- The inspector observed children engaging in activities in the indoor area.
- The inspector spoke to members of staff and children at appropriate times during the inspection.
- The inspector took account of the views of parents and school staff spoken to on the day of the inspection.
- The inspector looked at a range of documentation, including policies and procedures.

Fundayz was registered in 2009. The club employs two members of staff and operates within Alt Primary Academy in Oldham, Lancashire. It is open each weekday from 7.30am to 8.55am and 3.20pm to 5.30pm, during school term time. There were no children in the early years age range present at the time of the inspection.
