The setting does not meet legal requirements for early years settings

Summary of key findings for parents

The provision does not meet requirements

- The provider has failed to ensure that at least one member of staff holds a current paediatric first-aid certificate.
- The provider was unable to provide a record of Disclosure and Barring Service checks for all committee members.
- The provider is not sufficiently ambitious about motivating and supporting staff. They have failed to ensure staff are up to date with changes to legislation, with regard to learning and development.
- The provider understands their responsibility to notify Ofsted of any changes that may affect the space or quality of childcare that is provided.
- Staff have a sound understanding the child protection procedures approved by the Local Safeguarding Children Board. They are confident in their ability to take action to help keep children safe from abuse or neglect.
- The provider has a suitable range of resources and equipment for all children.
- Staff understand how to provide children with a healthy diet. This promotes children's health.
- Parents are provided with an information pack, including policies and procedures to help them understand how the setting operates. Staff understand the importance of working in partnership with parents and other professionals to ensure children's individual needs are met.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

What the setting needs to do to improve further

To meet the requirements of the Early Years Foundation Stage the provider must:

- ensure that there is at least one person who has a current paediatric first-aid certificate
 is on the premises and available at all times when children are present
- maintain a record of the criminal records disclosure reference number, the date a disclosure was obtained and details of who obtained it. Ensure the record is easily accessible and available to those who have a right or professional need to see them
- support staff to undertake appropriate training and professional development opportunities to ensure that they fully understand the learning and development requirements.

To meet the requirements of the Childcare Register the provider must:

ensure that at least one person who is caring for children has an appropriate first-aid qualification (compulsory part of the Childcare Register).

- The inspector toured the areas of the premises where childcare is to be provided.
- The inspector discussed with the manager how she intends to deliver the educational programme for children.
- The inspector looked at policies and documents the manager will use when caring for children.
- The inspector checked evidence of suitability and qualifications of the staff working with children.

Southfield Kids Club was registered in 2002 and is run by a voluntary committee. The club employs two members of childcare staff. They both hold appropriate early years qualifications at level 3. Sessions are from 7.30am to 9am and 3pm to 5.30pm each weekday, during term time. During school holidays the club is open each weekday from 8am to 5pm, depending on demand.

This inspection was carried out by Ofsted under sections 49 and 50 of the Childcare Act 2006 on the quality and standards of provision that is registered on the Early Years Register. The registered person must ensure that this provision complies with the statutory framework for children's learning, development and care, known as the Early Years Foundation Stage.

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
