- Staff demonstrate that they are able to work cooperatively with parents and share information between the provision and home, in order to ensure continuity of care and learning for children.
- Staff have a secure knowledge and understanding of how to promote the learning and development of young children and provide programmes that are educational, interesting and challenging.
- Staff are aware of the need to offer a welcoming environment to help children and parents feel at home in the setting and to ensure that this positively supports their emotional well-being.
- Staff have established positive links between the setting and the various schools where children attend. They understand the importance of partnership working to ensure they are able to continue to meet the individual needs of all children.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

#### **Inspection activities**

- The inspector held meetings with the provider and the manager of the provision and spoke to staff throughout the inspection when appropriate.
- The inspector checked safety records, the provider's evidence of self-evaluation and a range of other documentation.
- The inspector checked evidence of the suitability and qualifications of the staff working with children.
- The inspector had a tour of the out-of-school facilities and observed activities indoors and outdoors.
