Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- The management and staff have a sound knowledge of the requirements of the Early Years Foundation Stage. They demonstrate a good awareness of planning a balance of adult-led and child-initiated activities based on children's individual interests to support their overall progress.
- The staff clearly explain the suitable measures which are in place to make sure that children's health and well-being would be effectively promoted. Arrangements for the provision of healthy snacks are clear. Any individual preferences would be discussed with parents.
- The staff have a clear understanding of the importance of working in partnership with parents, other early years providers and local schools. This enables them to promote continuity of care for children and support their emotional well-being.
- The management and staff have an appropriate knowledge and understanding of how to safeguard children. They have attended relevant training and know what procedures to follow should they have any concerns. This helps to protect children's welfare.
- Management and staff demonstrate a commitment to improvement. They would seek the views of children and parents to identify the strengths of the club and areas for further development. In addition, they use the Ofsted self-evaluation form to reflect on their practice.
- Clearly written policies and procedures in place, such as safeguarding, the use of mobile phones and cameras and complaints. This contributes to the safe and smooth running of the club.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

Inspection activities

- The inspector viewed all areas of the setting and the range of toys, equipment and resources available for children in the early years age group.
- The inspector held discussions with the provider and staff regarding their knowledge and understanding of the requirements of the Early Years Foundation Stage.
- The inspector looked at and discussed a range of records, policies and procedures with the provider and staff.
- The inspector checked evidence of suitability and qualifications of staff working with children, and the provider's self-evaluation form.

Kids Zone Cadbury Time Club was registered in 2001. The club employs four members of staff. Of these, three hold appropriate early years qualifications at level 3 and above and one at level 2. The club opens Monday to Friday, from 8am until 9am and from 3.15pm until 6pm, during school term time.

This inspection was carried out by Ofsted under sections 49 and 50 of the Childcare Act 2006 on the quality and standards of provision that is registered on the Early Years Register.
