Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- The childminder demonstrated through discussion that she has a good understanding of how to implement the learning and development requirements. She knows how to use observation and assessment to aid planning for children's individual needs.
- The childminder maintains a safe environment for children. She demonstrates a sound knowledge of the safeguarding and welfare requirements, and has a range of policies to underpin her practice in supporting children's well-being.
- The childminder demonstrates through discussion and documentation that she clearly understands her responsibilities in meeting the requirements of the Early Years Foundation Stage. She has evaluation systems in place and attends training to improve further her own knowledge and skills.
- The childminder demonstrates that she understands how to work in partnership with parents and others to promote a joined-up approach to meeting children's care and learning needs.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

Inspection activities

- The inspector discussed with the childminder how she meets the learning and development requirements when caring for children.
- The inspector looked at the childminder's documentation, including the policies she has regard to when childminding.
- The inspector observed how the childminder maintains a safe environment for children.
- The inspector discussed evaluation and improvement with the childminder.

The childminder registered in 2006. She is registered as a childminder in her parents' home, in Farnborough, Hampshire. The childminder sometimes works with her mother, who is also a registered childminder. The childminder has a degree in early years education. She works Monday to Friday, for most of the year. There were no children on roll at the time of the inspection.
