- Children can move about the various rooms freely. The venue is easily accessible for all children, including those with additional needs and/or a disability, offering different play experiences for a wide range of needs.
- The nominated person has a good knowledge of the procedures to follow in the event of child protection and children's welfare concerns, in order to safeguard them.
- The nominated person has a strong knowledge and understanding of offering an inclusive service for all children so they benefit from attending.
- The setting is able to work with parents to ensure they meet children's individual needs. They gain detailed information from parents so they are clear about children's specific needs. This means they understand what they need to do to support them.
- The setting understands the benefits of seeking the views of parents and children to help evaluate their effectiveness and make targeted changes to practice.

There were no children present when this inspection took place.
