Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- The childminder has a clear understanding of her responsibilities in meeting the requirements of the Early Years Foundation Stage. She has evaluation systems in place and attends training to further improve her knowledge and skills.
- The childminder has a good knowledge of the learning and development requirements. She understands how to use observation and assessment to aid planning for children's individual needs.
- The childminder knows how to work in partnership with parents and others to promote a consistent approach to meeting children's care and learning needs.
- The childminder understands how to maintain a safe environment for children. She has a clear understanding of how to safeguard children's welfare and support their wellbeing.
- The childminder provides a welcoming environment for children. She has a wide range of resources available to children that promote their all-round development.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

Inspection activities

- The inspector discussed with the childminder how she meets the learning and development requirements when caring for children.
- The inspector observed how the childminder maintains a safe environment for children.
- The inspector looked at the childminder's documentation, including the policies she has regard to when childminding.
- The inspector discussed self-evaluation and continuous improvement with the childminder.
