## Summary of key findings for parents

### The provision meets requirements

- The childminder has a good knowledge of safeguarding issues. She ably describes the signs and symptoms of abuse and the procedures she would follow to make a referral if she had concerns about a child in her care.
- The childminder understands how to plan for children using her observations, children's interests and information from parents. She has good knowledge of child development and demonstrates how she uses this knowledge to plan for children's next steps in learning.
- The childminder provides a clean and welcoming environment. She minimises risk to children's safety and provides a varied range of good quality resources for children to choose from.
- The childminder understands how to develop positive partnerships with parents. She has developed systems that enable her to provide regular information for parents using diaries and daily discussions.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

## **Inspection activities**

- The inspector reviewed areas of the childminder's home used for childminding.
- The inspector held discussions with the childminder to establish her knowledge of the Early Years Foundation Stage.
- The inspector reviewed documentation, including the childminder's qualification certificates.
- The inspector reviewed the available resources that the childminder provides for children to support their learning.
