## Summary of key findings for parents

### The provision meets requirements

- Staff have a secure knowledge of the Early Years Foundation Stage requirements and know the correct procedures to follow to help safeguard children's welfare.
- Staff maintain secure premises to prevent any unauthorised access to the children's playrooms.
- Staff plan and provide a suitable range of activities to support children's developmental stage and interests. These are stored in labelled boxes for children of all ages to choose for themselves.
- Staff understand the importance of promoting children's self-confidence, communication skills and behaviour to promote their future learning skills.
- Staff understand how to promote children's healthy lifestyles. They provide regular physical play activities for children and conduct risk assessments to help keep children safe.
- Staff understand how to work in partnership with parents and school staff to meet children's individual needs and emotional well-being.
- Staff, parents and children contribute to the evaluations of the setting to drive continuous improvements in the quality of children's care.
- Management understands how to monitor and promote staff's knowledge and understanding of the Early Years Foundation Stage. Staff attend ongoing training to help them promote children's individual needs and welfare.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

- The inspector discussed the management's knowledge of the Early Years Foundation Stage requirements.
- The inspector looked at the documents management use to assess the suitability of staff, and discussed the policies.

Kingston and Wimbledon YMCA Out of School Care and Creche (Activity Centre) registered in 2005. It operates from Wimbledon, located in the London Borough of Merton. The club is open during term time only from 2.30pm to 6pm. The club employs two members of staff who hold appropriate early years qualifications at levels 2 and 3. There were no children present at the time of inspection.

This inspection was carried out by Ofsted under sections 49 and 50 of the Childcare Act 2006 on the quality and standards of provision that is registered on the Early Years Register.
