

## **Compliance action taken for childcare provision**

### **Summary of outcome**

On 11 March 2015 Ofsted received information that raised concerns about the suitability of those working with the children.

These concerns relate to the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) welfare requirements, in particular to the requirement for Suitable People which states that people looking after children are suitable to fulfil the requirements of their roles.

We carried out an unannounced investigation looking into this concern and risk to children; to assess whether the registered provider was meeting requirements for registration relating to Suitability of staff and Safeguarding practices.

We liaised with other agencies as part of our investigation and decided that the provider was no longer suitable to be registered with Ofsted.

As a result we cancelled the provider's registration.

### **Publication of compliance action**

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website

for a period of five years commencing on the date we complete our investigation.
