Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- The childminder has a secure understanding of the safeguarding and welfare requirements, and the learning and development requirements.
- The childminder has an understanding of the required records to be maintained to support the welfare of children in her care. She has a range of policies and procedures to share with parents to support the service she provides.
- The childminder recognises the importance of working in partnerships with parents and other professionals if required.
- The childminder welcomes the support of her local authority to keep her informed of training on offer and about relevant changes to support her in her development.
- The childminder has met previous recommendations raised at her last inspection, to promote children's learning outcomes and to work in partnership with other professionals.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

- The inspector spoke to the childminder about her understanding of safeguarding and welfare requirements.
- The inspector spoke to the childminder about her understanding of the learning and development requirements.
- The inspector looked at a sample of documentation the childminder uses when minding. This includes children's required records, and policies and procedures shared with parents regarding the childminder's role and responsibility.
- The inspector discussed with the childminder her self-evaluation processes and training.
- The inspector looked at areas of the childminder's home and garden area used for childminding purposes.
