The provision meets requirements

- The childminder has a sound understanding of the learning and development requirements and her role to promote children's learning, through observation and assessment.
- The childminder is aware of the importance of partnership working with parents and other early years providers to support continuity in children's care and learning.
- The childminder has a sound understanding of her role to protect children and promote their safety. She has suitable procedures to follow if she has any concerns about a child in her care. She has the required policies and procedures in place to share with parents so they are informed of her responsibilities.
- The childminder has appropriate arrangements to promote children's behaviour and to deal with any accidents or respond to children who are unwell.
- The childminder takes appropriate action to maintain an up to date knowledge of childcare practice through her attendance on relevant training courses.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

- The inspector engaged in discussions with the childminder about her practice.
- The inspector sampled a range of documents, including children's records and some policies and procedures that the childminder uses to underpin her practice.

The childminder registered in 2008. She lives in Clapton in the London Borough of Hackney. The childminder provides care all year round, except summer holidays, from 7am to 7pm. There were no children in the early years age range present during this inspection.
