### Summary of key findings for parents

#### The provision meets requirements

- The manager and staff have a clear understanding of safeguarding and child protection and are able to explain the settings policies. This means that children are kept safe and protected from harm or abuse.
- There are systems for supervision in place which provide support, coaching and training for staff to enhance their skills.
- The out of school club works in partnership with the school and parents to plan for improvements.
- All documentation meets requirements and supports the smooth running of the setting.
- The indoor and outdoor play areas are safe and organised to meet the needs of children.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

Odessa School out-of-school club registered in April 2005. It is registered on the Early Years Register, and the compulsory and voluntary parts of the Childcare Register. It is owned and managed by the East London Black Women's Organisation. The out-of-school club is situated in the main hall of Odessa Infant School, in Forest Gate within the London Borough of Newham. The out-of-school club opens during term times, from 3pm until 6pm, and is open during school holidays from 8.00am until 6pm. All children have access to a secure outdoor play area. There are currently no children attending in the early years age group. The out-of-school club employs four members of staff, all of whom have appropriate childcare qualifications.

This inspection was carried out by Ofsted under sections 49 and 50 of the Childcare Act 2006 on the quality and standards of provision that is registered on the Early Years Register. The registered person must ensure that this provision complies with the statutory framework for children's learning, development and care, known as the Early Years Foundation Stage.
