Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- Staff understand how to safeguard children. They ensure children's safety by appropriate supervision and risk assessment. Staff know the procedures to follow if they have concerns about a child.
- Staff promote children's health. They provide healthy snacks and children have plenty of exercise outdoors.
- There are secure partnerships with parents. They share essential information, which supports children's care and learning.
- Staff plan activities that include children's interests and support their continued development.
- The manager and staff review practice regularly, including children in the evaluations of activities to help identify improvements. They have addressed the recommendation from the last inspection, offering children access to a good range of books, as they are able to use the school library.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

Inspection activities

- The inspector toured the premises.
- The inspector looked at a sample of policies and procedures, including safeguarding, complaints and behaviour management.
- The inspector held discussions with the owner, manager and staff regarding safeguarding practice.
- The inspector held discussions with the manager and staff regarding the support for children in the early years age group.

Winterbourne Croydon Children's Club registered in 2003. The club operates within Winterbourne Junior Boys School, which is in the London Borough of Croydon. The club is open each weekday for a breakfast session from 7am, and after school from 3.25pm to 6pm, during term time. The club employs five members of staff, all of whom hold appropriate early years qualifications at level 2 or level 3. There were no children present in the early years age group during this inspection.
