

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

On 22 May 2015 we received information that raised concerns about the provider's ability to safeguard children following an accident to a child. At an inspection we looked at the concerns to see whether the provider was meeting the Early Years Foundation Stage requirements relating to Safeguarding Practice: in particular the effectiveness of risk assessments, child supervision and staff deployment. This inspection found that a space to the side of a door had been found by children. Although this had not been previously identified as a potential risk, the provider and manager took immediate and swift action as soon as they became aware of the hazard. Risk assessments have been reviewed and appropriate action has been taken to reduce further incidents. In addition, we found that children are well supervised by staff who are well deployed and ratios are met at all times. No further action is required. The provider remains registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years commencing on the date we complete our investigation.
