The provision meets requirements

- The provider ensures staff plan activities to meet the children's individual needs and enable them to make progress.
- The staff work with teachers to provide continuity of care for the children. They share information so staff can progress children's learning and development further.
- The provider understands the requirement to promote positive behaviour in children, and works with parents and other agencies to support children with challenging behaviour.
- The provider has clear and concise safeguarding policies and procedures, which staff follow to safeguard children.
- The provider monitors the provision effectively and assesses areas for development. Staff attend training to develop their knowledge, which benefits the children.
- Staff promote children's health and well-being by offering balanced meals and regular exercise. This also promotes their physical development.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

Waterways After School Club is run by Greenwich Integrated Services. It registered in 2005 and operates from a purpose-built building. It is situated adjacent to Hawksmoor Primary School in Thamesmead. The after-school club is open each weekday from 3pm to 6pm for 38 weeks of the year. The club employs five members of staff, all of whom hold appropriate early years qualifications. There were no early years children present at the time of inspection.

This inspection was carried out by Ofsted under sections 49 and 50 of the Childcare Act 2006 on the quality and standards of provision that is registered on the Early Years Register.
