Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- The leadership team demonstrates how they meet the learning and development requirements of the Early Years Foundation Stage. They describe how they plan and provide a variety of purposeful experiences, which help engage and support the children's learning and development.
- The leadership team have a secure understanding of safeguarding children, with detailed procedures to follow. All staff receive regular training on child protection, so they understand their responsibility to identify concerns and respond appropriately, following their Local Safeguarding Children Board guidance.
- The leadership team support staff to promote a healthy lifestyle and safe environment. They ensure staff are aware of the importance of encouraging children to keep hydrated during the camp sessions, and that they provide an environment that is clean, safe and suitable for children to explore.
- There are robust recruitment procedures to ensure that all persons working with children are suitable to do so. The leadership monitors and supervises the staff team, regularly seeking and continually providing them with training opportunities, to advance their skills and overall practice.
- The leadership team understands how to promote good partnership working with parents and professionals, to help meet children's needs.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

Ultimate Activity Camps at Headington School registered in 2013. It operates from Headington School, Oxford, Oxfordshire. The setting operates on weekdays, during most school holidays, from 8am until 6pm, with an activity programme from 9.30am until 4.30pm. The setting employs six staff, of whom two hold relevant qualifications, including Qualified Teacher Status. There were no children present in the early years age range at the inspection.

This inspection was carried out by Ofsted under sections 49 and 50 of the Childcare Act 2006 on the quality and standards of provision that is registered on the Early Years Register. The registered person must ensure that this provision complies with the statutory framework for children's learning, development and care, known as the Early Years Foundation Stage.

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
