The provision meets requirements

- The provider has a good understanding of the Early Years Foundation Stage requirements. She knows how to provide a safe and secure environment for children and promote children's care and education.
- The provider has a good understanding of how to monitor and meet the individual needs of children. She knows how to plan activities and resources to support children with special educational needs and/or disabilities.
- The provider has a good knowledge of safeguarding procedures and ensures staff have a good understanding. She attends training to recruit staff effectively and knows how to identify and report any concerns, to maintain children's welfare.
- The provider ensures staff develop professionally in order to drive improvement. Staff complete training before the playscheme starts. Well-qualified staff ensure children receive good care and education.
- The provider establishes good partnerships with parents. This motivates and builds children's confidence.
- The provider effectively promotes diversity. She provides resources which help children to have a positive attitude. She provides equipment specific to children's needs. This promotes their well-being and meets their physical and emotional needs.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

- The inspector discussed with the provider her knowledge of the Early Years Foundation Stage requirements.
- The inspector checked areas of the provision used for the children.

Fig Playgroup and Playscheme registered in 2011. It operates in Harold Hill in the London Borough of Havering. The Playgroup is open each weekday from 8.30am to 3.00pm term time only and from 10.00am to 3.00pm during the school holidays. There are fifty-two members of staff, all hold early years qualifications to at least level 3. At the time of the inspection, there were no children of early years age present.
