The provision meets requirements

- Management and staff have a good understanding of how children learn and develop. They know how to provide a variety of activities for children of different ages and levels of ability. They understand the importance of using children's interests and specific needs in their planning to promote outcomes for children.
- All staff understand the safeguarding policies and procedures. They know how to identify and report child protection concerns, and complete ongoing safety checks of the premises and outings to identify and address any potential hazards. This promotes children's welfare.
- Staff are experienced and knowledgeable about how to work with children who are learning English as an additional language.
- Staff know how to promote children's learning about the local community and wider world effectively, including individual differences in society.
- Management understand the importance of monitoring and reflecting on practice to make sure that they meet the statutory requirements and continue to improve the quality of provision.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

Camden Chinese Community nursery registered in 1986. It is run by a voluntary committee and is located in the London Borough of Camden. The nursery employs six members of childcare staff. Of these, three of whom hold appropriate early years qualifications, including one with Early Years Professional status. The nursery opens each weekday for 51 weeks on the year from 8am to 6pm. The nursery receives funding for free early education for children aged two, three and four years. There were no children present at the time of the inspection.

This inspection was carried out by Ofsted under sections 49 and 50 of the Childcare Act 2006 on the quality and standards of provision that is registered on the Early Years Register. The registered person must ensure that this provision complies with the statutory framework for children's learning, development and care, known as the Early Years Foundation Stage.

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
