## Summary of key findings for parents

### The provision meets requirements

- The childminder has a good knowledge of how to safeguard children. She understands about ensuring her home is safe and is aware of protecting children's health and well-being, including knowing the procedures to follow if she has any concerns about a child's welfare.
- The childminder has developed her understanding of observing and assessing children's development to enable her to plan for each child's individual interests and needs.
- The childminder's home is welcoming and she understands the importance of having suitable toys and resources to promote children's learning and development.
- The childminder understands the importance of keeping her skills and knowledge up to date, and about attending continuous training to help improve her skills further to benefit children.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

### Inspection activities

- The inspector discussed with the childminder about how she intends to deliver learning together with the childminder demonstrating some of her resources.
- The inspector discussed with the childminder her safeguarding knowledge and about how she intends to keep children safe from harm.
- The inspector looked at policies and documents the childminder will use when caring for children.
- The inspector discussed self-evaluation and continuous improvement with the childminder.
