Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- The childminder has a good understanding of child development. She understands how to observe children so that she can assess and plan for their learning.
- The childminder provides a varied range of resources to promote children's development in all areas of learning.
- The childminder understands how to provide a clean, safe and welcoming environment for children.
- The childminder understands how to meet children's emotional needs when they are settling in with her. She has clear procedures to work in partnership with parents to support children's good behaviour.
- The childminder has a thorough knowledge of safeguarding issues. She understands the signs of when a child may be at risk of harm and has clear procedures to follow if she had concerns about a child's well-being.
- The childminder demonstrates a good capacity to keep up-to-date with current guidance so that she can review and improve her provision.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

- The inspector discussed aspects of the requirements of the Early Years Foundation Stage to establish her knowledge and understanding.
- The inspector reviewed evidence of the childminders qualifications and suitability to care for children.
- The inspector reviewed documentation used by the childminder to support her provision.
