Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- Staff demonstrate how to provide appropriate learning opportunities to challenge children and extend their learning.
- Staff demonstrate a suitable awareness of how to promote children's understanding of a healthy lifestyle. They explain how they would provide a choice of healthy snacks and daily opportunities for exercise.
- Staff demonstrate how they work in partnership with parents and the host school to complement children's learning.
- The provider understands how to safeguard children. The recruitment procedure is robust, regular evacuation drills take place and risk assessments contribute towards keeping children safe.
- Leaders constantly strive to improve the quality of care and learning children receive. Questionnaires, feedback and information from parents, children, staff and external agencies are used to improve practice.
- Staff have a good understanding of how to promote children's positive behaviour, tolerance and mutual respect of others.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

Inspection activities

- The inspector viewed some of the provider's documentation, including training certificates, policies and the records of staff and children.
- The inspector held discussions with the provider to assess whether they are able to meet the care, learning and development needs of the children.
- The inspector had a tour of the premises and all outdoor areas that are used by children.

Precious People Childcare Services was registered in 2011 and is owned by Precious People Childcare Services. The club is open each weekday during school term times. Sessions are from 7.45am until 8.50am and 3pm until 5.30pm. Four members of staff work with the children. One member of staff has a relevant qualification at level 6 and three staff have relevant qualifications at level 3.

This inspection was carried out by Ofsted under sections 49 and 50 of the Childcare Act 2006 on the quality and standards of provision that is registered on the Early Years Register. The registered person must ensure that this provision complies with the statutory framework for children's learning, development and care, known as the Early Years Foundation Stage.

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
