Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- The provider demonstrates a suitable knowledge of safeguarding procedures and knows how to refer any concerns to the relevant agencies.
- There are adequate systems to supervise and monitor staff practice. They are encouraged to attend training to develop their knowledge and skills.
- There is a suitable range of toys and resources for children to keep them occupied and promote their all-round development.
- The provider understands the importance of the partnerships with parents and schools to support children's development and complement their learning elsewhere to help provide a consistent approach.
- The provider provides a key person for younger children, when they attend, to support their welfare and emotional well-being.
- The provider understands the importance of teaching children to keep themselves safe and healthy.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

Inspection activities

- The inspector checked the suitability of the premises, indoors and outdoors, and the resources that are available to promote children's learning.
- The inspector discussed the provider's understanding of the safeguarding and welfare requirements, and the systems she has in place to help keep children safe.
- The inspector looked at and discussed policies, procedures and documents the provider will use when caring for children.
- The inspector checked the evidence of qualifications and suitability of the provider including her paediatric first-aid certificate.

Chill Out of School, Cuddington registered in 2009. It operates from Cuddington Community Primary School in Worcester Park, Surrey. The club operates Monday to Friday from 7.45am to 9am and 3pm to 6pm during term time. The club employs the required number of qualified staff when operating. The manager holds a childcare qualification at level 3. The club operates a holiday play scheme from 8am-6pm. There were no children on roll at the time of inspection.

This inspection was carried out by Ofsted under sections 49 and 50 of the Childcare Act 2006 on the quality and standards of provision that is registered on the Early Years Register.
