Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- The childminder demonstrates a secure knowledge and understanding of the Early Years Foundation Stage and meets all the requirements.
- The childminder knows how to plan suitable activities to promote children's learning and to monitor their progress. She understands how to adapt activities to meet the learning needs of all children, ready for school.
- The childminder understands how to encourage children to behave well and respect others. She understands the importance of good hygiene, providing healthy meals and providing children with daily fresh air and exercise.
- The childminder ensures her home is safe and regularly reviews the premises for potential hazards.
- The childminder understands the importance of training and self-evaluation in improving her provision for children.
- The childminder understands the value of developing partnerships with parents, keeping them informed about their children's progress and promoting children's education at home.
- The childminder has a secure understanding of safeguarding issues. She knows the procedures to follow if she has concerns about children's safety and welfare.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

Inspection activities

- The inspector held conversations with the childminder during the inspection, including discussions about her understanding of requirements.
- The inspector sampled some of the childminder's documentation, including her policies and procedures.
- The inspector checked evidence of the childminder's suitability and qualifications.
- The inspector viewed the premises and resources available for children.
