Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- The childminder understands the Early Years Foundation Stage requirements and how to help children to make progress.
- The childminder values children's backgrounds and understands how to help them learn about other languages, communities and cultures.
- The childminder undertakes training, recognising the need to continue to improve her knowledge and skills.
- The childminder knows how to observe and assess children's progress. She understands how to plan activities that reflect their different ages, interests and abilities, to meet their individual needs.
- The childminder understands how to keep her home safe and secure for children. She keeps her safeguarding knowledge and procedures up to date so that she knows what action to take if she had concerns about a child's welfare.
- The childminder knows how to work in partnership with parents, schools and other settings involved in children's care.
- The childminder knows how to teach children about positive behaviours, so that children learn to value and respect the needs of others.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

- The inspector discussed with the childminder how she plans to deliver the educational programmes for children.
- The inspector looked at the childminder's paperwork and viewed the areas of her home available for childminding use.
