Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- The childminder knows how to carry out risk assessments indoors and outdoors to reduce the risk of hazards when caring for children.
- The childminder has an understanding of child protection issues and safeguarding procedures to ensure she is able to act promptly if she has any concerns about the welfare of a child.
- The childminder has an understanding of how to promote children's health. She knows how to follow hygiene procedures, provide nutritious meals and encourage children to take part in physical activity.
- The childminder understands the importance of establishing partnerships with parents to provide consistent care and learning for the children.
- The childminder has an understanding of how to help children learn to show care and concern for others and the environment.
- The childminder knows how to assess children's abilities and use her knowledge to plan activities to help children make progress in all areas of learning.
- The childminder attends training courses to update her knowledge and knows how to evaluate her practice to improve her childcare skills.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

Inspection activities

- The inspector had discussions with the childminder about her childcare practices.
- The inspector went on a tour of the premises with the childminder.
- The inspector sampled a range of documentation, including qualification and training certificates, an accident and incident book and safeguarding policies.
