Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- The childminder understands child protection procedures and knows what to do if she has concerns about a child's welfare.
- The childminder knows how to maintain documents to meet the requirements of the Early Years Foundation Stage. These include public liability insurance and an up-to-date paediatric first-aid certificate.
- The childminder understands how to promote children's care and learning.
- The childminder knows how to help children develop an understanding of a healthy lifestyle to promote their physical well-being.
- The childminder understands the importance of working in partnership with parents and other professionals involved with children to help ensure that children receive consistent support.
- The childminder understands the importance of carrying out risk assessments to minimise hazards to children.
- The childminder is committed to developing her professional knowledge through further training.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

Inspection activities

- The inspector toured the areas of the childminder's home used by children.
- The inspector viewed a range of documentation, including policies and procedures, public liability insurance and suitability checks.
- The inspector held discussions with the childminder about different aspects of her practice and how she plans to promote children's learning and development.
- The inspector discussed safeguarding procedures with the childminder.
