- The provider has strong links with the local schools and knows how to liaise with them in order to provide continuity of care for the children.
- The staff know how to plan a wide range of activities for all children, taking into account their individual needs and interests.
- The provider understands how to forge good partnerships with parents. They know how to share essential information to support children's care and learning.
- Staff understand how to promote children's good health and provide them with plenty of exercise and healthy meals. They understand how to promote good behaviour and encourage children to respect others.
- The manager and staff review practice regularly. They understand the benefits of gaining the children's views in their evaluations of activities, to help identify and make improvements.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. Croydon Children's Club operates from a scout hall in Norbury, in the London Borough of Croydon. The provider operates a breakfast club before school, which opens at 7am, and an after-school club from 4pm to 6pm. The club is open each weekday during school term times.
