Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- The childminder understands the requirements and has kept up to date with them. She knows how to provide children of different ages and stages of development with a range of learning experiences.
- The childminder knows how to observe, assess and monitor children's developmental stages and plan for their future achievements.
- The childminder knows how to work in partnership with parents. She understands how to manage any complaints by implementing her complaints policy. She shares children's progress with parents and requests their involvement with their child's learning.
- The childminder understands how to identify any possible welfare concerns a child may have. She knows to report these promptly to the relevant agencies.
- The childminder knows to ensure she continues to develop her professional practice by undertaking further training courses.
- The childminder understands how to promote children's understanding of diversity. In addition, she knows to teach children about behaviour rules and respect for others.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.
