Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- The childminder meets the safeguarding and welfare requirements and knows how to keep children safe. She keeps her safeguarding knowledge up to date and knows what to do if she has concerns.
- The childminder understands her responsibility to meet the learning and development requirements. She knows how to work in partnership with parents to support children's care and education.
- The childminder is aware of how to observe and assess children's learning. She knows the importance of supporting individual children's needs to help them make progress in their learning and development.
- The childminder knows how to help children build respectful relationships with each other and to help them understand others who are different than themselves.
- The childminder evaluates her setting which helps to continually improve outcomes for children.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

The childminder registered in 2003 and in Sittingbourne, Kent. She runs her service from 7.30am to 6.30pm, Monday to Friday term time only. There were no children on roll at the time of inspection.
