## Summary of key findings for parents

### The provision meets requirements

- Robust systems for the recruitment, vetting, induction and training of staff and volunteers ensure adults working with the children are suitable to do so. Staff have a good knowledge of the Early Years Foundation Stage requirements. They are confident in demonstrating their understanding of how to safeguard children.
- The provider implements secure policies and procedures to promote the health, safety and well-being of all the children who attend.
- Staff, parents and children are included in how the management team evaluate their practice. As a result, the management team can plan effectively in order to promote their continuous improvement.
- The out-of-school setting promotes equality and inclusion very well. The environment and resources support children's individual needs extremely well.
- Staff ensure that they know the children well. Effective procedures are in place to maintain an ongoing dialogue in working with parents and other professionals involved in children's care. This means that staff are confident to promote continuity in the learning and development children receive elsewhere.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

## **Inspection activities**

- The inspector accompanied the manager on a tour of the setting.
- The inspector spoke to staff and the management team.
- The inspector met with the provider and manager. They discussed how the setting works with parents, and other agencies involved with the children.
- The inspector discussed with the provider how they plan for their future improvement and how they evaluate their provision of care.
- The inspector sampled the out-of-school's documentation.

Linkable Woking Limited originally registered in 1989, and re-registered in 2015. LinkAble is a registered charity covering the boroughs of Woking and Surrey Heath. The group is based in Woking, Surrey. They operate weekdays, doing holiday periods from 9.30am to 3.30pm, and on Saturdays from 10am to 2pm. There are more than 30 staff and many volunteers working with the charity. However, there are 14 staff working directly with the children on any one day. Of these, four staff hold appropriate childcare qualifications. On the day of the inspection, there were no children present in the early years age range.

This inspection was carried out by Ofsted under sections 49 and 50 of the Childcare Act 2006 on the quality and standards of provision that is registered on the Early Years Register. The registered person must ensure that this provision complies with the statutory framework for children's learning, development and care, known as the Early Years Foundation Stage.

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
