Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- The childminder's home is free from hazards. She knows how to carry out risk assessments to minimise potential hazards to children.
- The childminder has a range of toys and equipment for children of different abilities.
- The childminder has an understanding of child protection issues and knows how to proceed if she suspects that a child is at risk of harm.
- The childminder knows how to promote children's health, for example, through daily routines and exercises.
- The childminder understands the importance of working partnerships with parents and external agencies to provide continuity of care and learning for children.
- The childminder understands how to use observations and assessments to plan play experiences, to help children progress in all areas of learning.
- The childminder knows how to use a range of strategies to manage children's behaviour and develop their awareness of diversity.
- The childminder has attended training courses to keep up to date with childcare practices. She knows to evaluate her practice to develop her service.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

- The inspector had discussions with the childminder about her childcare practices.
- The inspector viewed the furniture, toys and equipment for children.
- The inspector sampled a range of documentation, including qualifications, and training certificates and policies.
