Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- The childminder has a sound knowledge and understanding of the Early Years Foundation Stage. She understands her role in providing appropriate learning opportunities that meet children's individual needs and help them to progress.
- The childminder knows how to safeguard children and she has clear reporting procedures in place should she need to report any concerns.
- The childminder maintains a clean and well-maintained environment. She keeps a suitable range of resources that cover all areas of learning.
- The childminder understands the importance of working in partnership with parents and other professionals to meet children's care and learning needs.
- The childminder understands how to promote children's health and well-being. She talks about providing children with healthy meals and snacks, and daily opportunities for fresh air and exercise.
- The childminder knows how to manage children's behaviour positively. She understands her role in developing children's awareness of the needs and feelings of others.
- The childminder understands the importance of evaluating her practice and accessing regular training to improve her skills.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.
