Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- Arrangements for safeguarding are effective. The childminder demonstrates a suitable understanding of her roles and responsibilities and how to safeguard children in her care.
- The childminder undertakes effective risk assessments to ensure her home is safe. She provides a welcoming and secure environment and a range of resources and equipment. This enables children to make their own decisions about where they play and what they do.
- The childminder has suitable systems in place to observe and assess children's progress. She demonstrates a secure understanding of the need to work in partnership with parents and outside professionals. This ensures children receive the support and intervention they need in order to make the best possible progress.
- The childminder keeps the required documentation and implements a range of written policies and procedures. She shares relevant information about her service with parents in order that they are clear about her practice and how she cares for their children.
- The childminder explains how she helps children learn to play together within her setting. She sets clear expectations about behaviour boundaries and understands the importance of teaching children how to manage their own feelings and consider the views of others.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

Inspection activities

- The inspector discussed with the childminder how she meets the needs of children in her care.
- The inspector looked at a range of documentation, including training certificates, policies and procedures and children's records.
- The inspector viewed the premises and looked at the play equipment and resources available for children to use.
