Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- The childminder meets the safeguarding and welfare requirements. She knows her role in keeping children safe and free from harm.
- The childminder recognises the importance of promoting children's personal development so they learn to behave well and to respect others.
- The childminder understands the need to promote the learning and development requirements. She understands how to provide activities that help all children to learn, whatever their backgrounds, abilities and ages. She understands the need to help children to make progress and to be ready for the next stage, including school.
- The childminder understands the importance of working with parents, and of gathering information about children to be able to meet their physical needs.
- The childminder understands the importance of reflecting on the quality of her service and of undertaking training to improve her service.

There were no children present when this inspection took place.
